Striping run in the Roof of the World

After a two-year partnership, frequent exchanges and field visits (memorable visits!), the HÉVÉA team is proud to have been actively involved in the essential oil striping run in the Roof of the World!

This unique experience took place at over 3700 meters above sea level and was attended by our local partner, Karpo, a Buddhist Master and renowned doctor of the Valley of Dzongsar.

The essential oil chosen for the first initial test is *Sabina Squamata*, of the juniper family named Spama and used by the Tibetans for traditional incense making.

Besides the contribution made for the implementation of the distillation unit which has made it possible to produce this precious essential oil, HÉVÉA has also trained local teams for the production of natural cosmetics.

Among those products, a cosmetic balm which can be marketed through our partner in those Tibetan drugstores which form part of a distribution network. This **natural product** has been designed for the local population for skin protection against the harsh climate conditions in highland areas.
